ZOE LEONARD (CAMDEN ARTS CENTRE, LONDON) A group of analog images Leonard made this year foregrounded a subject that we-in contrast to the mechanical apparatus that made them-can observe only with difficulty, and at some risk to our eyesight: the sun. Leonard coupled these modest photographs with a walk-in camera obscura, Arkwright Road, 2012, which gave viewers the uncanny sensation of inhabiting a vast, animate photograph. This fine-tuned selection of works challenged its audience to question habitual modes of observation, by revealing perception itself to be perplexing and problematic.
